Fish Fry Dinners Summary

As everyone knows, we hosted six (6) Fish Fry dinners throughout the Fridays of lent and accumulated many assets and turned an outstanding profit! We served at least sixty (60) people at all of the dinners, and actually served over 80 people at three (3) of the events. We spent a total of \$2,161.89 on expenditures to buy food, cookware, plate-ware and other items necessary to cook and serve dinner, and we collected \$4,066.00 in revenue. That leaves us with a whooping profit of \$1,904.11! I pleased to have hosted, SO am coordinated and supervised these dinners, and to have received the overwhelmingly positive responses from parishioners and clergy alike. We had MANY repeat customers, and they all expressed that the food was **OUTSTANDING!**

Also, the feedback from the parishioners has resulted in a request that we host a Fish Fry Booth (tentatively named "Fish Friars") at the 2012 Fiesta of the Bells! We don't have time to coordinate this activity for the 2011 Fiesta, but we will plan on hosting the Fish Friars booth next to our Poker Knights booth, and entice our Knights to volunteer for the boots with some outstanding fried fish!

We will definitely do this again next year, and we will make even more money because we now have all of the assets needed to complete these Fish Frys. I would like to personally thank every single volunteer, I could not have done this without our collective effort! Great job and I'm looking forward to our Fish Frys next year!


Chaplain's Report

Historical Corner



After receiving permission from his superiors, he set sail for the Americas, departing Cadiz, Spain in 1749 along with 19 other Franciscans.

He journeyed first to Mexico City, where he taught. Father Serra refused to ride the mule that was provided him and walked from Veracruz to the capital. He was bitten by a snake and suffered from it throughout his life, though he continued to make his journeys on foot whenever necessary. He requested a transfer to the Sierra Gorda Indian Missions some 90 miles north of Santiago de Querétaro, where he spent about nine years. During this time, he served as the mission's superior, learned the language of the Pame Indians, and translated the catechism into their language. Recalled to Mexico City, he became famous as a most fervent and effective preacher of missions. His zeal frequently led him to employ extraordinary means in order to move the people to penance: he would pound his breast with a stone while in the pulpit, scourge himself, or apply a lit torch to his bare chest. He established ten missions including Velicata. [more to follow in subsequent monthly newsletters].
